Data protection officer shall provide information about the processing of personal data in the Medical SPA.

#### Who processes Your data?

We inform you that upon submitting an enquiry, a request, or a complaint to the e-mail of the Medical SPA, further on Your data will be collected and processed by *Data processor* "Eglės sanatorija" AB (registration number of a legal person 152038626, address Eglės g. 1, Druskininkai, tel. (8 313) 2, e-mail address office@sanatorija.lt) in adherence to the provisions of GDPR and in exercise of the obligations prescribed in the law.

### Which, for what purpose, and on which legal grounds Your personal data is processed?

We inform you that if You were to submit an enquiry, request, or complaint to the e-mail of the Medical SPA, it shall be deemed that we have entered into a contract and on these grounds, we shall process Your data (GDPR Article (6)(1)(b)). Therefore, in effort to maintain the communication between You and Us, We will process the following personal data of Yours: name, surname, e-mail address, the contents of an enquiry, a request, or a complaint, the date, the answer to an enquiry, other information submitted by You.

Upon submitting an enquiry, it might be required to submit some additional information about You so we could properly respond to Your enquiry.

No sensitive information about You is collected and we ask you to not provide us with such information. If You were to provide us with such information, we shall deem that You have consented to our processing of such personal data

If the provision of sensitive data is necessary due to lodging a complaint or making a request or an enquiry, this information will be stored in accordance with law obligation.

## To whom may we transfer Your data?

No personal data of Yours that is processed for the purposes of responding to Your enquiries, requests, or complaints will be transferred to anyone.

We may provide access to Your personal data to the director, the employees that are responsible for the procurement, the providers of IT, server, archiving, and legal questions, but obligating these service providers or employees to ensure data confidentiality and proper protection.

*Do we transfer information about You beyond the boundaries of the European Economic Area?* The information about You is not transferred beyond the boundaries of the European Economic Area.

#### For how long do we store Your data?

The information about You that We process to respond to Your enquiries, requests, or complaints will be stored for two years following the day of the submission of an enquiry, request, or complaint.

### What rights do You have?

We inform that You, as a data subject, under the legal acts of data protection and if You were to submit a written *request*, may exercise these rights of a data subject:

- 1. The right to access the information about data processing;
- 2. The right to access the data;
- 3. The right to rectification or having incomplete data completed;
- 4. The right to erasure ("right to be forgotten") or to suspend the processing activities (except storing);
- 5. The right to limit the processing;
- 6. The right to data portability;
- 7. The right to object the data processing;
- 8. The right to lodge a complaint with the State Data Protection Inspectorate.
